

## Homework Expectations



You will find that your child will have homework on most nights with the exception of weekends. Each child has been given a homework assignment book and is required to record their daily homework assignments. We ask that you sign their book each night. It is our hope that this will develop a sense of responsibility in each student and will help keep you informed of their daily homework and our expectations. Please keep in mind that homework is not meant to be a punishment but rather reinforce what is taught in class. That being said, here are some general guidelines of what to expect each evening.

**Math:** Study links or journal pages reviewing and practicing what has been taught in class.

### Spelling:

#### Green Group:

- Monday: Learn and Spell worksheet due Tuesday
- Tuesday: Sentences due Wednesday (see expectations below)
- Wednesday: Worksheet A, or B and C due Thursday
- Thursday: Study for Friday's test.

#### Purple Group:

- Monday: Begin sentences (due Wednesday)
- Tuesday: Continue working on sentences and work packet (due Thursday)
- Wednesday: Finish work packet and study words
- Thursday: Study for Friday's test

#### Sentence Expectations:

- I remembered to use a complete heading.
- I used a variety of sentence beginnings
- I checked for capital letters and end punctuation
- I underlined my spelling words
- I skipped a line after each sentence
- I wrote at least 7 words in each sentence
- I wrote meaningful sentences
- I was neat with my handwriting

\*5 points off for each misspelled spelling word. 1 point off for any other misspelled word or any grammatical error.

**Reading:** Book projects will be assigned monthly. Please see Book Project link. Students are expected to read 20-30 minutes each evening.
