

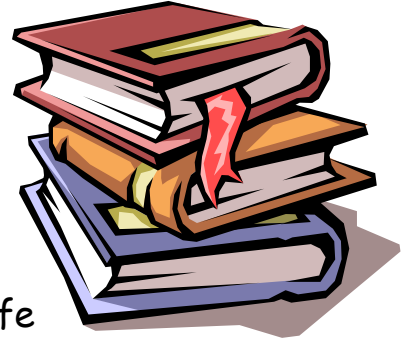
Welcome to Mrs. Fitzpatrick's Web Page!
