If your child is in **Mrs. Trombley's, Ms. Purinton's, Mrs. Plunkett's, Mr. Shepherd's, Mrs. Benjamin's or Mrs. Bissonnette's class**, they will perform on Wednesday, February 10.

Now some specifics...

What time do students arrive at Colchester High School and where do they go when they get there? Students should arrive at **6:15 pm** and meet their classroom teacher in the Colchester High School **Cafeteria**, which is directly across from the Theater. There will be no teacher supervision until then, so please keep your child with you until your classroom teacher arrives. Please take your child's coat/boots with you. Nothing should be left in the Cafeteria when we begin the performance.

What should my child wear to the performance? Students do not need to get dressed up. The important thing is that they are comfortable in whatever they are wearing as they will be standing and sitting on risers. The stage lights can make things very warm on stage. Sneakers are recommended. Please, no slippery footwear, or heels.

How long will the performance last? The musical will be approximately 30 minutes.

How will students be dismissed from the stage? After the performance, students will be escorted by their classroom teacher back to the Cafeteria. Parents, please meet up with your child's teacher before leaving so they know students are properly picked up.
