


How & when to apply — FSA ID

- Student applying for aid and at least one parent on the FAFSA **each** need create an account FSA ID (dependent student).
- Takes time to set up: More security = more questions.
- Use non-school email address
- Can do NOW.

How & when to apply

File your FREE Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- · Required.
- Available October 1, 2021.
- Use 2022–2023 version (the year student will attend college).
- · Check college deadlines.
- Add colleges later if student applies early and then decides on more schools.

How & when to apply

File your Vermont grant application

- Open to all Vermont residents on October 1, 2021.
- Use 2022–2023 version (the year student will attend college).
- Required for state grant aid.
- Apply early, check status, and complete.
- Can fill out forms online, upload documents.
- Students must create MyVSAC account before applying.

What is the EFC/family contribution and how is it determined?


The family contribution is a starting point — ${\bf not}$ what you have to pay.

- Look farther (in state, other states, Canada).
- Dual enrollment
- Early college
- Advanced Placement
- NEBHE
- Start at a school that costs less, then transfer.
- Consider attending local and commuting.

Next steps for senior year


- Research forms and deadlines required by colleges. Meet earliest deadline.
- Create Federal Aid accounts <u>FSA ID</u>, one for student and one for parent.
- \bullet Create $\underline{\text{MyVSAC}}$ account for student.
- Gather family financial aid info to file applications
- \bullet File the FAFSA and VT grant applications.
- File VSAC's Unified Scholarship Application.
- Apply for other scholarships
