Developing and Using Models in Science

Just like the CCSS math standards have a set of mathematical practices, the Next Generation Science Standards have a set of eight NGSS Science and **Engineering Practices.** One of these practices is Developing and Using Models. In grades 3-5 this can look like drawing diagrams or creating physical replicas to aid in asking questions and generating explanations as well as to Communicate Information to Others, another Science and Engineering practice. Utilizing the large whiteboards allows students to generate models in science and engineering.

The whiteboards can be used for more than just science instruction. The <u>Common Core Mathematical Practices</u> and the NGSS Practices have many similarities. The Common Core Math Practices include," Model with Mathematics" and "Construct Viable Arguments and Critique the Reasoning of Others."
