Diversity Lessons: A set of diversity lessons was created by a group of UMS teachers under the guidance of the district's Diversity Equity and Inclusion Coordinator. They are developmentally appropriate and aimed at raising awareness among the students. The fourth and final lesson being taught next week is:

Lesson 4: Caring Community/Being an Upstander

This lesson addresses the <u>Social Justice Standards</u>: I care about those who are treated unfairly. I can and will do something when I see unfairness – this includes telling an adult. The students will learn what it means to be an upstander: someone who listens to others, speaks up when something is unfair and stands up to act if someone is being hurt or treated unfairly. Students, with the guidance of the teacher, will brainstorm developmentally appropriate actions they can take to be an upstander.
