Once you get to the page that says "Hello!" you can stop.

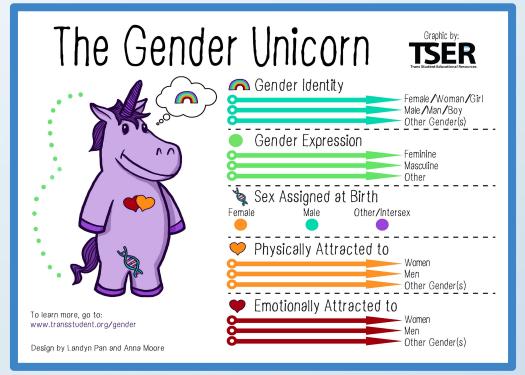
*If you have already started the Common App, use this time to continue working and or review/ proofread

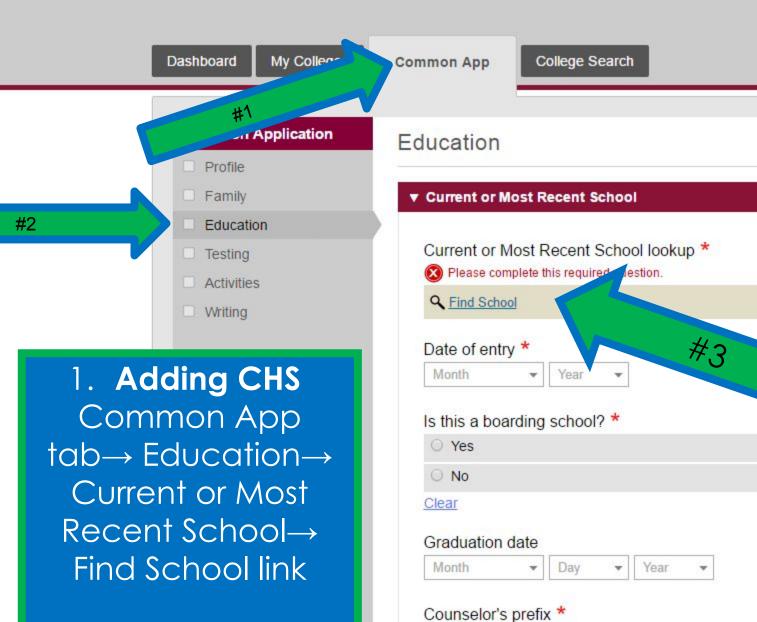
*PLEASE set aside some time at home to work on your Common App. This will **not** be something you complete during AT

Profile Section changes

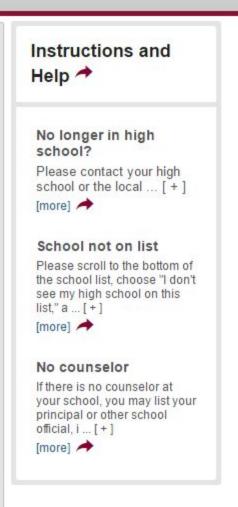
 Students will answer the question of "Sex" and have to answer Male or Female BUT there is a section that says "If you would like the opportunity, we invite you to share more about your gender identity below."



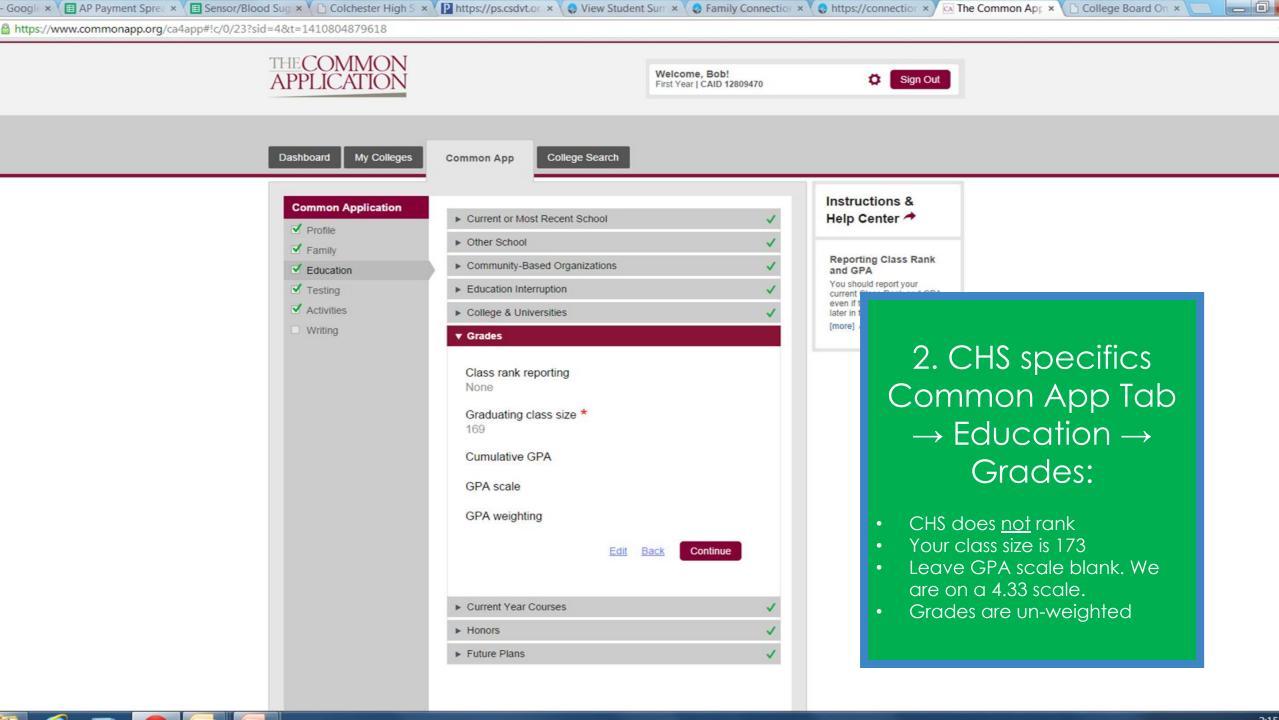

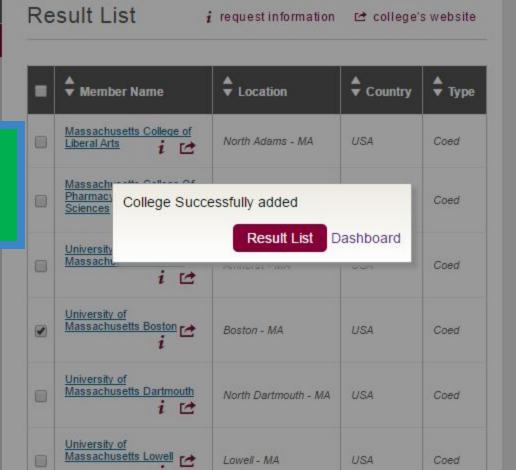

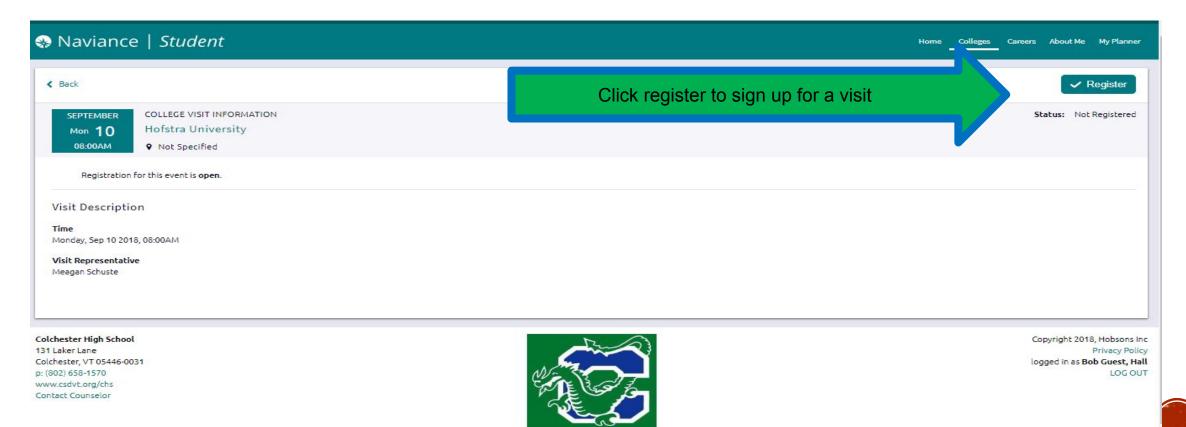


The Pink Form

- □ Nothing will be sent to schools until this form is signed and given to Mrs. Ward
