We are excited to announce that the CSD Food Service Program will once again be offering a free **School Break Food Bundle** for the upcoming April Break. The bundles are open to any family, regardless of income, and will include free meals (5 breakfasts and 5 lunches) for children 18 and younger.

This will be our third food bundle of the year and each time we have fine-tuned how to order, make, package, and distribute hundreds of meals for the program. For April Break, we are going to adjust our sign-up and distribution process to have better success on pick-up day.

How to Order:

To order a free food bundle, please call Sara at 264-5743 between the hours of 7:30 am - 1:00 pm before Friday, April 9. This is the only way to order a food bundle, there will be no online sign-up.

How to Pick Up:

For those who place an order with Sara, your bundle will be delivered by bus on Wednesday, April 14 to the Remote Meal Delivery Stop closest to your house. See route stops and times below.

If you have a conflict and cannot receive your bundle by bus delivery, please let Sara know when you sign up and we can make special arrangements for you to pick it up at Colchester High School that Wednesday evening, April 14 from 4:00-6:00 PM.

You can expect breakfast items like waffles, bagels, cereal, fresh fruit, and a build your own yogurt parfait. For lunch, there will be things like chicken tenders, personal pan pizza, homemade mac and cheese, shepherd's pie, frittatas, veggies, and fruit. Each family will also receive a gallon of milk.
