COVID-19 Vaccine Now Available to Ages 5+ and Boosters Open to 16+

The COVID-19 vaccine is now available for children ages 5 years and older at state-run clinics, many health care providers and some pharmacies. As a reminder, there is a vaccine clinic for ages 5-11 tomorrow at MBS from 9 am - 3pm. There are still spots available, register here: https://vermont.force.com/events/s/selfregistration.

Additionally, 16 and 17-year-olds are now able to receive a booster shot once six months out from their second dose. Learn more, review FAQs, and make an appointment through the Vermont Department of Health's vaccine website.

International Travel Guidance

With many traveling for the upcoming winter break, we wanted to remind families and employees that while there are no restrictions on stateside travel, after returning to the United States from international travel, it is recommended that:

- All travelers get tested for COVID three to five days after travel.
- Self-monitor for <u>COVID symptoms</u>; isolate and get tested if you develop symptoms.
- If you are **NOT** fully vaccinated, in addition to the testing recommendations above:
 - Stay home and self-quarantine for a full seven days after travel, even if you test negative between three to five days.
 - If you don't get tested, stay home and self-quarantine for 10 days after travel.
