CSD Community,

We have expanded the <u>Classroom Exposure List</u> on our website to include all grades in the district. PreK-12 classroom exposure data will be kept on the website throughout the five-day testing/monitoring period. The website also includes testing options for those exposed. As a heads up, this website is often updated by our nurses or the COVID Response Team as the cases are being processed and before email notifications are made to elementary classrooms or middle school teams. It's important to note that end-of-day exposure notification emails do not include additional information beyond what is listed on the website. Those emails are simply a supplemental means of notification.

If you're interested in this information, the site can be accessed at your convenience through the main CSD COVID Dashboard at <a href="https://www.csdvt.org/covidcases">www.csdvt.org/covidcases</a> and by clicking on "Exposures List" next to the school name. You can also get to it by selecting "Classroom Exposure List" from the side menu.

Additionally, we wanted to let families and employees know that the district has received an ample supply of take-home antigen test kits. Regardless of vaccination status, if a student or employee has an in-school or out-of-school exposure, rapid test kits are available for pick up at the CSD Test to Stay Program located at the <u>Bayside Activity Center</u> at 36 Blakely Rd between 6:30 - 8:30 am each school day. In addition to picking up test kits, if you've <u>provided consent</u> and the student or employee is not experiencing symptoms, the program can also perform a test that morning before school.

We hope this information is helpful to our community as we continue to move into the next phase of this pandemic.
