Colchester School Board Public Comment Rules

Colchester School Board meetings are held on the first and third Tuesday of each month. Meetings begin at 7:00 p.m. in the Colchester High School Media Center (Library). Meetings are open to the public unless warned otherwise. Citizens have an opportunity to speak or comment on any item listed on the agenda following the board's discussion. For topics not listed on the agenda, public comment can be made during the "Citizens Participation" agenda item.

Every member of the public will have an opportunity to address the board on a topic of concern. The rules for public comment are:

- 1. Each speaker will have three minutes to speak.
- 2. Speakers must remain civil. The Board will not tolerate profanity or shouting.
- **3.** The Board may choose not to respond to any statements or questions raised. Public comment is your opportunity to speak with the Board.
- **4.** The Board may ask you to complete your comments if your remarks are redundant.
- **5.** Every speaker is expected to identify themselves by announcing their name and place of residence.
