- Literary & Non-fiction

- Upper grade scores
- Closing the achievement gap for students on free/reduced lunch

Weaknesses

- Analysis & Interpretation
- Lower grade scores
- Students with disabilities

Use short and long pieces of text

Ask students to respond to questions that extend beyond the text

Connect reading and writing opportunities


Focus on comprehension in classroom and support instruction





Strengths

- Numbers & Operations
- Single answer (multiple choice, single operation)
- Lower grades
- Exceed state standards by large margins in upper grades

Weaknesses

- Geometry & Measurement
- Multi-step questions, applying the skill or concept
- Upper grades

Embed geometry and measurement practice into daily routines

Strengthen geometry and measurement math units

Practice multistep problem solving


Focus on the "big ideas" within each math unit


- Grades 5, 8 & 11
- Grades 5 & 8 assess type of response for many genres of writing (Persuasive, Narrative, Report)

Multiple choice Short Responses Extended Response


- Grade 11 assesses many genres of writing (Response to Literary Text, Response to Informational Text, Reflective Essay, Report, Persuasive Essay & Procedure)
- Grade 11 focuses on 1 genre of writing each year Response to Literary Text (2012-2013)

Strengths

- Multiple Choice (Gr. 5 & 8)
- Reflective Essay (Gr. 11)
- Exceed state averages by large margins in 2 grades (Gr. 5 & 11)

Weaknesses

- Extended Response (Gr. 5 &8)
- Response to Informational Text (Gr. 11)
- Scoring on rubric most scored 3 or 4 out of 6 possible points

Have students respond to text – fiction and non-fiction

Use exemplars to show students work with high expectations

Use scoring guides that match up with NECAP expectations

Practice short and extended responses to text Pathway A: High Standards, Expectations, and Individual Engagement for All Learners
