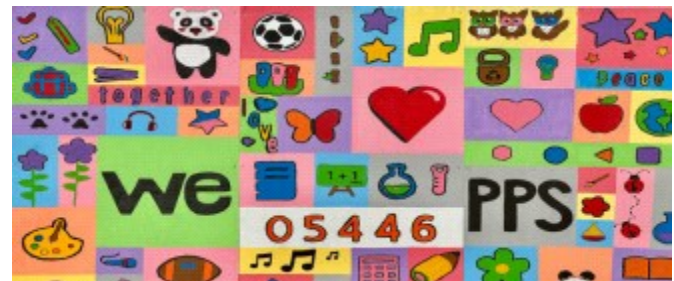

PPS Action Plan Highlights

Math and Literacy: Increase achievement outcomes for all students in the areas of Math and Literacy by

- Examining student work monthly to monitor impact on learning.
- Adjusting instruction related to identified grade level standards.
- Implement Phonics to Reading program consistently (K-3)

Social-Emotional Learning: Provide direct instruction in emotional and self-regulation strategies using the Zones of Regulation program and research-based intervention strategies.

Equity: Expand our use of materials and lessons related to equity and social justice in coordination with Union Memorial School (UMS).

100% of PPS teachers are highly qualified

The average daily student attendance rate was 96%

52 students qualified for and received reading intervention support

38 students accessed math intervention help

182 (82%) students had 0 to 1 behavior referrals in 2023-24
