Board of Education Meeting Colchester High School Library Tuesday, April 20, 2010 7:00 p.m. (General Session)

The Colchester Board of Education held a regular board meeting on Tuesday, April 20, 2010 at the Colchester High School Library. MINUTES (General Session)

I. Call to Order, Pledge of Allegiance

Board Chair Dirk Reith called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

V. Land Mitigation Request from Town for New Police Station

The state permitting process would require the school district to further mitigate land use for an additional four acres. Business and Operations Manager, George Trieb, reviewed the current land mitigation required as part of the permitting process for the new athletic fields. The school board would like to invite the town to a future meeting to discuss the topic further.

VI. Timeline for Next Budget Vote

Superintendent, Larry Waters, provided the board with an overview of the tentative timeline for the next budget vote. The plan would be to have the vote on the same day as the town (May 18th). Director Dick Pecor moved, seconded by Board Chair Dirk Reith to approve the timeline for the next vote. Motion passed 4-0-1.

VII. Request to Open Negotiations with Administrators

Superintendent, Larry Waters, advised the board that the ACA was willing to open negotiations for salaries for FY'11. The board had a proposal from the ACA for consideration. Director Mike Rogers moved, seconded by Director Dick Pecor to open negotiations with the ACA. Motion passed unanimously.

VIII. New Recommended FY'11 Budget

Superintendent, Larry Waters, provided the board with a brief presentation outlining the proposed budget cuts. Proposed cuts totaled \$512K. This would result in an overall budget increase of 0.64% or \$203K over the current year's plan. A lengthy discussion followed.
