- The line item for teacher contracts increased by 3.3%. Does this mean that all teachers received an increase of that amount?
- If this budget does not pass at the March 3 vote, what does the school board plan to do? Where will the cuts be made?
- Why does the district look to cut sports and other after school programs first?
- Does the district pay for teacher's pension?
- What are some of the recent mandates from the state that are unfunded?
- Can you give any other examples of responsibilities that Vermont school districts assume today that are above and beyond reading, writing and arithmetic? (e.g., nutrition, social/family, etc.)
- Can the district ignore or choose not to follow mandates that are coming from the state?
- If this budget is approved, how much will my taxes go up?
- If the budget did not go up and you level funded, would taxes still go up?
- How does Colchester compare to other districts in Chittenden County and Vermont with spending for students?
- What are some of the ways in which Colchester Schools are trying to conserve or even saving valuable taxpayer dollars now and in the future?
