### MINUTES (General Session)

The Colchester Board of Education held an open session on Tuesday, November 17, 2015 in the Colchester High School Media Center. Those in attendance were: Board Chair Mike Rogers; Directors Lindsey Cox, Craig Kieny, Curt Taylor and Lincoln White; Superintendent Larry Waters; Business & Operations Manager George Trieb; Special Guests: Dave Sharpe, Chair House Education Community; Maureen Dakin, Legislator; Joey Purvis, Legislator; and Lisa Bell, Colchester Athletic Booster Association. ## I. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

# III. Hear Act 46 Discussion with House Education Committee Chair, D. Sharpe

House Education Committee Chair, David Sharpe, shared with the board and community information related to Act 46 on School Governance (Merger) and Allowable Growth. A copy of his presentation is posted on the district's website.

### IV. Hear Financial Report and Update from Colchester Athletic Booster Association (CABA)

CHS Principal Minor and CABA Treasure Lisa Bell provided the board and community with a financial overview of the association along with purchases made for CHS athletic programs. Ms. Minor indicated that CHS is in need of additional funding (\$58K) in order to support the current athletic programs at CHS.

# V. Hear First Draft of Baseline Budget-FY'17

George Trieb provided the first draft of the FY'17 Baseline Budget to the board and community. The Baseline Budget is simply rolling forward current programs and personnel with adjustments in salary and benefits. He provided rationale for the cost adjustments in all objects from 110 to 290. Currently the increase in the baseline budget is about 3.16% or about \$1.2M. The second draft of the FY'17 Budget is requests for new programs/personnel. When we apply the baseline budget to the Allowable Growth Caps it is estimated that the district will exceed the growth by about \$220 on a per pupil based if we use FY'16 estimated revenues and net equalized pupils; however, it is probable that both of the amounts will increase substantially bringing the Allowable Growth down and within the \$13,851 amount.
