MINUTES (General Session)

The Colchester Board of Education held a regular board meeting on Tuesday, September 15, 2015, in the Colchester High School Media Center. Those in attendance were: Board Chair Mike Rogers; Directors: Lindsey Cox, Curt Taylor, and Lincoln White; Superintendent Larry Waters; Director of Curriculum & Instruction Gwen Carmolli; Director of Special Education Carrie Lutz; and Principals Chris Antonicci, Julie Benay, Michele Coté, Carolyn Millham, and Amy Minor. I. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

IV. Smarter Balance Assessment Report on Students with Disabilities & Poverty (See attached report)

Gwen Carmolli, Director of Curriculum & Instruction, provided the board and community with the assessment percentages for students who were proficient on the SBAC assessment in Literacy and Math. The percentage of students achieving the standards in both content areas is very low and concerning to us particularly for the subgroup with Disabilities. We do not have state averages for a comparison at this time. The district will disaggregate the scores and include new action in our improvement plans for all schools.

V. Approval of First Reading of the Personnel Leave Policy

School Board approved the first reading of the Personnel Leave Policy with the amendments provided.

VI. Hear Update on Plan to Study Educational Opportunities for Early Education Center

Currently, the group will conduct a review of research and best practices as it relates to the structuring of grades and prekindergarten programs. The committee will provide a report to the board with their findings but not necessarily recommendations. At a later time the report will include community opinion. The school board would like a short list of talking points regarding the EEC to reference when they are asked questions by the community.
