What is a State Placed Student?

- Student living in Foster Care through DCF or Mental Health Agency
- Legal Guardian lives outside of Colchester



State Placed

- Spirit of the Law (ESSA)
 - ◆ Education Stability



GOAL

Increase identification, enrollment, stability, and school success for children living in Foster Care

- Best Interest Determination
 - ◆ Where Legal Guardians live
 - ◆ Last Foster Placement
 - ◆ New Foster Home

→ Transportation

◆ DCF provides

→ Out of Foster Care

◆ Enrollment and Transportation Throughout the School Year

Vermont Data

March of Year	2015	2016	2017
# of Students	1,256	1,351	1,311

- This number is a sampling, not the total per year.
- This was the last three years in the month of March
- Typically the total would be a little higher.
- This does not include students placed by Mental Health

Funding



- Special Education we get reimbursed for 100% of the cost above the mainstream supports
- Extra Costs for a student not in Special Education can be reimbursed up to 100%. (504 or EST)
- General Education students same ADM
