COVID-19 Meeting Participation

On March 30, 2020, Governor Scott signed H.681 into law, making temporary changes to Vermont's Open Meeting Law. These changes will remain in effect during the declared state of emergency due to COVID-19. On November 13, 2020, the Governor amended the executive order as a result of an acceleration in COVID-19 transmission throughout the State. The addendum strongly discourages in-person meetings. Meetings of the Colchester School Board will be held remotely with no designated meeting location.
