Dear MBS Families,

Our fourth graders will be returning for the first week of in person instruction beginning tomorrow. We are looking forward to having them back in the building! Thank you for your flexibility with the changes we made to our dismissal routines last week as we welcomed our third graders in the building.

This past Friday, October 23rd, the Vermont Agency of Education issued a new set of guidelines for a Strong and Healthy Start. It is possible that some of our routines and systems will need to be modified as a result of these guidelines. As a district we are currently reviewing the guidelines and will keep you informed about any changes we need to make as a result of these guidelines.

We are extending our dismissal time for pick up until 3:20. We begin our dismissal process at 3:00 and currently have a rush of traffic in between 3:00 and 3:10. If you are able to, please feel free to come between 3:10 and 3:20 when there is less vehicle traffic. This will help us with the high volume of traffic in the parking lot and bus loop. We have staff who are available to provide students with supervision until 3:20.

**Colchester School District will be hosting virtual Family Nights.** These family nights will be with local experts covering a variety of topics including resilience, anxiety, fostering connections, and promoting independence in children. 
We still have 3 spots available in our Afterschool Archery Clinic on October 27th for grades 3-5.
