

### **PRESCHOOL**


In February, we will be investigating balls. Some concepts we will discuss are force and motion, gravity, velocity, energy, circumference, diameter, and size. We will work with pulley systems, ramps, pendulums, tubes, and catapults. There will be an investigation into how/which balls bounce in the science area. Children will be encouraged to make predictions on whether a ball will bounce or not and tell why they think that way. It should be a very busy and engaging study.
