PRESCHOOL

Preschool wrapped up their dynamic unit on balls and shapes this week. The children experimented with gravity, force, momentum, and energy and 3D shapes. They made and tested predictions explaining their thought processes along the way.

March will be our buildings and constructions unit. The children will explore buildings in their community and around the world, making connections on how they are the same and different. They will have the opportunity to build with different materials such as cardboard, different sized tubes, boxes, popsicle sticks, clothes pins, and more. They will practice balancing objects and measure objects using non-standard measuring tools (blocks, unifix cubes, paperclips) to see which is the tallest or widest. The children will be challenged to imitate premade structures, create blueprints for structures to be created, and draw what they have built.
