Happy sunny weekend! As the weather warms up and we enter the last weeks of this school year, I wanted to give you some information about transition and the 21-22 school year:

For the 21-22 school year, students in K-5 will be notified of their teacher placement on August 6th. We are still awaiting guidance from the State Agency of Education about the 21-22 school year and want to make sure we have all of that information prior to finalizing our class placement process. Before the end of this school year we'll be sure to provide you and your child of information about the the grade level they will enter. Incoming 6th graders will also receive summer notification about their new teacher and schedule from CMS.
