Playground Behaviors

We seeing an increase in playground behaviors this past week. This is consistent with data from past years. The conflicts that are coming up are often about gaga ball. Please:

- review gaga rules with students
- remind students to walk away from problems or use "rock-paperscissors" to solve disagreements.
- acknowledge students with tokens for safe respectful and responsible playground behavior
- make sure at least one person providing active supervision by the gaga ball courts if you are out on recess.

Please feel free to invite Jordan, Brooke, Lily, or Ryan into your classroom to talk more about recess conflicts and gaga ball with students.

Early Release Success!

Colchester School District began early release days in 2016 to give teachers and instructional support staff time to engage in professional learning together as one district, one of our overarching goals as a district.
