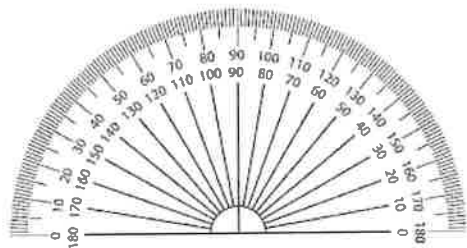
5th Grade School Supply List

Below is a list of some supplies you will need to complete and organize your school work in 5th grade.

1. Pencils (At least one box)
2. Spiral Notebook(for spelling work)
3. Composition Book (for writing)
4. 1 inch binder to hold academic work
5. Folder(s)-1 Home School Folder, other folders for subjects areas will be provided.
6. Earbuds/Headphones to have when using technology and SBAC testing

Optional Supplies

- Markers/colored pencils
- Erasers
- Pens
- Binder divider tabs (used to divide binder into different subjects)
- Folders
- White lined paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Pencil sharpener
- Pencil Case to hold supplies
- Protractor (used in math to measure angles)
