Diversity Lessons: We are going to continue the series of diversity lessons we started last year. These lessons were created by a group of UMS teachers under the guidance of the district's Diversity Equity and Inclusion Coordinator, are developmentally appropriate and are aimed at raising awareness among the students. The first lesson we will be teaching this year is:

Lesson 1: Identity and Empathy

This lesson addresses the Social Justice standards: *I can describe some ways that I am similar to and different from people who share my identities and those who have other identities* and *I like being around people who are like me and different from me*. The students will explore the many ways people are similar and different, self-confidence and empathy for all people. They will listen to a related text (<u>Marvelous Me</u> (K), <u>I Like Myself</u> (1) and <u>Same, Same but Different</u> (2)) and do an age-appropriate activity. If you want to continue the discussion at home, ask your child how they can make sure people know they care about them just the way they are.
