Bus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cross in front of the bus • Stay sitting in the seat the driver gives you 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be polite; use kind words • Be respectful to the driver and the bus 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No food or drinks (allergies, choking risk) • No animals • Level 0-2 voice
Cafeteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walk at all times • Keep your hands and feet to yourself • Sit with your bottom on the bench • Allergy safe table is for hot lunch and designated students only 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be polite; use kind words • Eat your own lunch; no sharing • Use good table manners 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay in your seat; wait for adult dismissal • Raise your hand if you need anything • Wait to be greeted before entering the cafeteria • Talk to those close to you • Level 0-2 voice
Hallway	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walk in a straight line while travelling as a class • Keep your eyes in front • Walk on the right side of the hallway • Keep hallways tidy of belongings 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use hallway hands and feet • Give a silent wave to friends 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Honor other's work by looking and not touching • Level 0-1 voice
Playground	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play within boundaries • Stay in sight • Tag – Yes; Chase – No • Play tag on the grass, not on the equipment • No throwing ice, sand, sticks, rocks or wood chips • Throw snow in the designated area 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be polite; use kind words • Share all playground equipment and return it when finished 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Come right in when the bell rings • Follow directions the first time • Level 0-4 voice
School-Wide Meeting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Classrooms sit in their assigned location 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give a silent wave to friends 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use whole body listening • Use whole school quiet signal, indicated by a clap and response • Level 0 voice
